



Star Spangled Card

Please note: This 5 1/2 x 8 1/2 inch note card is shown made with fabrics that are glued down. You can easily use construction paper, art papers or scrapbooking papers to make this pattern. If you would like to make this pattern as a classic appliqué pattern you MUST add seam allowances.

Materials:

- 3 x 8 inch piece red for stripes (C and D)
- 2 x 8 inch piece white for stripe (E)
- 4 x 4 inch piece for large stars (A)
- 2 x 2 inch piece for small star (B)
- 5 X 8 inch piece for background
- 5 1/2 x 8 1/2 card with envelope

Directions:

1. Cut out the pattern pieces: One large star (A), one small star(B), two red stripes (C and D), and one white stripe (E).
2. Cut two (2) large stars using pattern piece (A).
3. Cut one (1) small star using pattern piece (B).
4. Cut one red stripe using pattern piece (C).
5. Cut one red stripe using pattern piece (D).
6. Cut one white stripe using pattern piece (E).
7. Apply glue to reverse side of papers or fabric. Glue to background. Trim ends of stripes to fit your background. Allow to dry.
8. Apply glue to reverse of background, apply to front of card. Allow to dry.
